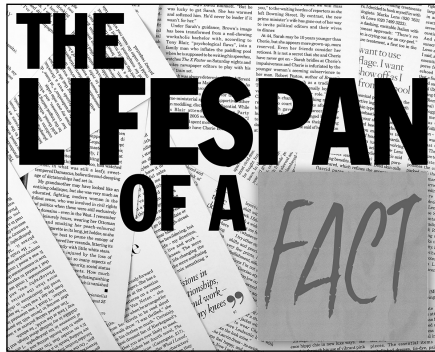

Welcome to the first production in our 20th Anniversary Season! This is a significant milestone for all of us at Good Theater, and we are very excited to bring you all six of the shows in our season line-up.

We have been sitting on many of these titles for several years due to Covid and the year we spent being dark. As plans for the season began to fall into place, I wondered if the shows would have the same relevance two years later. For me, *The Lifespan of a Fact* is as relevant, if not more so, in 2022 than it was in 2020.

For this special anniversary season, I wanted to feature as many of the local professional actors who have graced our stage in the past as possible. This first show stars three actors who have collectively been featured in 26 main stage productions. Jay Mack made his debut with Good Theater last season in *Lady Susan* and then made a second appearance in *Significant Other*. Denise Poirier has been working with us since our third season when she starred in *California Suite*. Since then she has taken on a wide variety of roles from musicals to dramas to comedies. The same can be said of Mark Rubin who began with *Enchanted April* (a very revealing role!) in season four and has graced our stage regularly since then.

Steve Underwood has taken the helm on this show while I've been working on our next show, *Carousel*. As we sat around reading scripts, Steve

was particularly drawn to *LIFESPAN* and he has done a great job bringing the show to life.

Voice work includes the title role of the animated *Aeon Flux* for MTV, Merrick in HBO's *Spawn*, *Starstruck* and *Vault of Horror* with Pocket Universe Prod. She's recorded audiobooks with Audible in NJ. She lived in L.A. (west coast version) for a lot of years where her TV career began with guest-starring roles on *Seinfeld*, *Murphy Brown*, *Frazier* and *3rd Rock From the Sun*. It's great to be home in Maine, and working with some of the best people in the world.

Mark Rubin (John D'Agata) is grateful to be working on this show with such talented artists. His Good Theater credits include *Lucky Stiff* (Vinnie), *Act One*, *Clybourne Park*, *August: Osage Country*, *Bedroom Farce*, *Light Up the Sky*, *Rabbit Hole*, *Shakespeare in Hollywood* and *Enchanted April*. Mark is a company member and current Artistic Director of Mad Horse Theatre Company (*The Effect*, *The Language Archive*, *Bloody Bloody Andrew Jackson*, *One Flea Spare*, *The Totalitarians*, *The Last Days of Judas Iscariot*, *Trevor*, *Lysistrata*, *Alligator Road*, *Vigils*, *Titus Andronicus*, *Bengal Tiger at the Baghdad Zoo* and *November*) and worked with various theater companies around Portland. He previously worked in the Washington, DC area at Arena Stage, Round House Theater, Project Y, Cherry Red Productions, and Olney Stage. Special thanks to

Steve Underwood (Director/Production Manager/Set Design) is the co-founder of Good Theater. As an actor, his favorite Good Theater shows have been *A Comedy of Tenors*, *Forum*, *Light Up the Sky*, *Ruthless*, *Shakespeare in Hollywood*, *Drood*, *The Dining Room*, *Barrymore*, *A Man of No Importance*, *Over the River and Little Me*. Steve directed *4000 Miles*, *Stones in His Pockets* and *Mrs. Mannerly* which was recently named Best Play in Maine by the BroadwayWorld Awards. Steve's one-man multi-media show, *Underwaterguy*, had its world premiere at Good Theater and was presented off-off-Broadway in NYC. His newest show, *The High Road*, will premiere in February of 2022. This one-man, mind-altering multi-media show about weed takes a deep dive into the fun and the fascinating, finding high-minded humor in the most unlikely places. *The High Road* is sure to give audiences a light-hearted lift and plenty of laughs in the middle of a long Maine winter.

Brian P. Allen (Executive & Artistic Director) co-founded Good Theater with Steve Underwood in 2002. This season marks the company's 20th year of operation. Over this time, he has directed approximately 90 productions for Good Theater. Recent credits include: the world premiere of *Jane Austen's Lady Susan*, *Harry Townsend's Last Stand*, *Desperate Measures*, *Admissions*, *Pack of Lies*, *Lucky Stiff* and *The Curious Incident of the Dog in the Night-Time*. Other theaters he has directed at locally include: The Theater at Monmouth, The Theater Project, Biddeford City Theater and Portland Players. Brian directed seven editions of the *Magic of Christmas* and a number of Pops concerts for the Portland Symphony Orchestra.

Michelle Handley (Costumes) this is Michelle's fourth production at Good Theater having previously created the costumes for *Jane Austen's Lady Susan*, *Desperate Measures* and *Significant Other*. She also designs for the University of Maine Orono's School of Performing Arts, The Theater at Monmouth, and The Public Theatre in Lewiston. When not costume wrangling, Michelle dwells in Monmouth, the proud mother of two beloved teenage humans. In her free time, she serves as clerk & photographer with the Monmouth Fire Department.

Michael Lynch (Box Office Manager) is in his 10th season with Good Theater where he has served as production stage manager, assistant stage manager, box office manager, and office manager. Michael has served as the assistant company manager at the Ogunquit Playhouse. You will find him most afternoons in the Good Theater box office and his evenings are spent herding actors, calling places and running a great show!

Iain Odlin (Lighting Design) went to an audition in 1986. As he arrived, an angry man stormed out of the theater past him. Puzzled but undaunted, he

continued inside and was greeted with the question, "Want to be our lighting guy?" Sometimes opportunity knocks the door off its hinges. Since then Iain has been 'lighting guy' for over a dozen companies. He serves as Good Theater's resident lighting designer creating lighting magic for such shows as: *Desperate Measures*, *Significant Other*, *Harry Townsend's Last Stand*, *Lady Susan*, *Curious Incident*, *Homer Bound*, *An Act of God*, *A Doll's House Part 2*, *Lucky Stiff*, *An Inspector Calls*, *A Comedy of Tenors*, *The Trip to Bountiful*, *Vanya and Sonia and Masha and Spike, Act One*, *Shear Madness*, *Mama's Boy*, *The Other Place*, *Regrets Only*, *The Rainmaker*, *Underwaterguy*, *Little Me*, *Clybourne Park*, *The Grand Manner* and *Next Fall* among many others. He also currently works with Naya's Trance, Dark Follies, the Stone Pinheads Ensemble and Vivid Motion and is Technical Director for St. Lawrence Arts.

Craig Robinson (Technical Director/Carpenter) is in his 20th year with Good Theater. Craig has also been the scenic designer for Good Theater's productions of *An Act of God*, *Hay Fever*, *Visiting Mr Green*, *Rabbit Hole*, *Light Up The Sky*, *The Little Dog Laughed*, *Moonlight And Magnolias*, *Next Fall*, *Death By Design*, *Becky's New Car*, *No Biz Like Show Biz* and *Mama's Boy*. In addition to building sets for Good Theater, he has built sets for Acorn Productions, Mad Horse Theater, SnowLion, and The Originals at Saco River Theater. Craig also does theater performance photography for many of the same companies.

Hannah Daly (Promotional Director & Social Media) is a Portland-based actor and educator who is thrilled to be returning to Good Theater for this exciting 20th anniversary season! GT credits: *The Trip to Bountiful*, *A Comedy of Tenors*, *A Doll's House: Part 2*, *Boxes* and *Jane Austen's Lady Susan*. She will be seen later this season in *You Can't Take it With You*. Additional credits include *A Christmas Carol* (Portland Stage), *Our Town* (Theater at Monmouth), and *The Moors*. (Dramatic Repertory Company). Film: *Downeast*. As an Associate Artist and Teaching Artist at Portland Stage, she performs and teaches in the Theater for Kids program *Play Me A Story*. 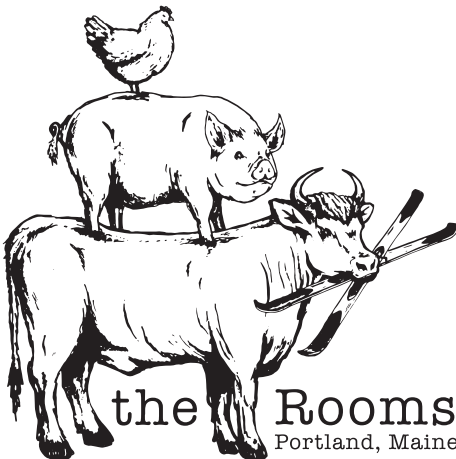
